You are expected to read what will be: discussed in class

No food allowed in class

Fire drills are planned and required When your teacher says good morning, you mumble it back

College

LEARNING environment VOLUNTARY and EXPENSIVE. Classes and time structured by YOU.

Need permission from SELF.
YOU are accountable.

You often have hours between classes; and class times vary

You arrange your own schedule You BUY your textbooks

Professors expect you to initiate contact if you need assistance.

Professors are available during posted
OFFICE HOURS

Professors expect you to figure out what you missed from classmates

Professors impart wisdom and expect you to synthesize it and learn

You NEED to study at least 2 to 3 hours per week per class

You are expected to read what will NOT be discussed in class.

"Results count."

Professors allow eating in class If you screw up, you won't be left off easy
